Why is attendance
important?

TTYP

Attendance is important because...

- You learn more. Every day in school, you learn something new. Missing a day means missing exciting lessons!
- You see your friends. School isn't just about learning; it's also about playing and making memories with your friends.
- You get better at things. The more you practice reading, writing, and maths, the better you get!
- It helps with routines. Going to school every day helps you get into a good habit of learning and being responsible.

DID YOU KNOW...

- Missing one day a week adds up! If you miss one day each week, you will miss:
- 5 days every month.
- 40 days in a school year
- 240 hours of learning.
- That's over 7 weeks of lost learning each year!

Punctuality is ...

- The act of being on time

DID YOU KNOW...

If you are 6 minutes late every day

- You would miss 19 hours of learning in a school year.

IF YOU ARE 9 MINUTES LATE EVERY DAY

- You would miss 28 and a half hours of learning in a school year - this is a whole week!
